Arriving at Camp on Sunday Registration and dorms open at 11:00am

Parking

O Please drive to Gate 2 where you will receive instructions on parking and what to do next (head to registration located in the Gallery).

Registration (in the Gallery)

- All campers must check in through registration.
- Once checked in, campers may go choose a bunk. There is one dorm for males, the Green House, and two dorms, Pierson and Beehive, for females.
- O Bunks may be saved for friends by placing personal belongings on them.
- All medication will need to be ready to turn in here.
- Electronics are NOT allowed at camp. Please make sure your camper leaves any electronic item with you at this time.

Lunch

- O You are welcome to purchase lunch tickets in the Gallery (at registration) for \$8.00 a person.
- O New campers will be required to have a ticket for this meal, but after that, all meals are included.
- Feel free to bring a picnic lunch to enjoy on Hummingbird's beautiful campus (please, no alcoholic beverages).

- O At 1:45, the campers from the previous week will perform. If it's an Art week, then there will also be an Art Show in the Dining Hall. If it is Chess week, there will also be an awards ceremony.
