## CODE OF CONDUCT & DRESS CODE POLICY

For the benefit of our entire camp community, we ask everyone to abide by the following:

### RESPECT FOR YOURSELF

- Take pride in yourself, your talent, and the great work you can do.
- Always do your best.

### RESPECT FOR LEARNING

- Be prepared and on time for your activities and rehearsals. Arriving late or being unprepared takes learning time away from your campmates and is a disruption to the teacher.
- Take care of the instruments, equipment and supplies in all rehearsal areas, art studios, and chess rooms.

### RESPECT FOR PROPERTY AND OTHERS

- Give people the privacy they deserve in the bunks. Boys are not to be around or inside the girls' dorm. Girls are not to be around or inside the boys' dorms.
- Be considerate of others with your actions, words, and clothing (this includes speech, music, magazines, and clothing that contain foul or suggestive language). It is not allowed at a children's camp.
- Treat others the way you would like to be treated.
- Pay attention to the requests of the Directors, Teachers, Office Personnel, Cooks, Head Counselors, and Counselors/CITs the first time you are asked.

### RESPECT FOR HEALTH AND SAFETY

- Leave camp only on official camp trips and signed-out emergencies.
- Do not ride in any staff member's private cars.

### FOLLOWING ARE NOT ALLOWED

- Knives (fishing knives are allowed with fishing equipment), weapons, or matches.
- Piercing any part of your or some one else's body, giving haircuts or shaving heads, and coloring hair.
- Physically striking another person.
- Teasing or bullying.
- Having cigarettes, alcohol, drugs (recreation or otherwise) or weapons.
- Being out of bunks between "lights out" and "rise and shine," except to use the restrooms or to visit the infirmary with your counselor.

Violation of any of these rules will warrant a call home and may result in an immediate dismissal from camp.

### DRESS CODE

- Underwear/undergarments and midriiffs should be fully covered.
- When your hands are by your side, shorts and skirts should extend to at least the end of your thumb.
- Footwear should be worn at all times (closed toed shoes will give you the best protection and support).
- Piercings & Tattoos: our camp is designed for children. While typical piercings are acceptable, please be mindful of tattoos and other body modifications.

\*Remember that Hummingbird is located in the mountains. Wearing comfortable clothes like shorts, jeans, athletic wear, t-shirts, tank tops, and sweatshirts (for cool mornings and evenings) works great!

Repeated violations of Hummingbird's Behavior and Dress Code Policies may result in dismissal from camp without a refund.
