

# Behavior and Dress Code

For the benefit of our entire camp community, we ask everyone to live by this code during your time at camp.

## I. Respect for Yourself

- a. Take Pride in yourself, your talent, and the great work you can do.
- b. Always do your best.

## II. Respect for Learning

- a. Be prepared and on time for your activities and rehearsals. Arriving late or being unprepared takes learning time away from your classmates and is a disruption to the teacher.
- b. Take care of the equipment and supplies in the studios.

## III. Respect for Property and Others

- a. Give people the privacy they deserve in the bunks. Boys are not to be around or inside the girls' dorm. Girls are not to be around or inside the boys' dorms.
- b. Be considerate of others with your actions, words, and clothing (this includes speech, music, magazines, and clothing that contain foul or suggestive language. It is not allowed at a children's camp.
- c. Treat others the way you would like to be treated.
- d. Pay attention to the requests of the staff members the first time you are asked.

## IV. Respect for Health and Safety

- a. Leave camp only on official camp trips and signed-out emergencies.
- b. Do not ride in any staff member's private cars.

## V. The Following are Not Allowed

- a. Knives (fishing knives are allowed with fishing equipment), weapons, or matches.
- b. Piercing any part of your or some one else's body, giving haircuts or shaving heads, and coloring hair.
- c. Physically striking another person
- d. Teasing or bullying of any kind
- e. Having cigarettes, alcohol, illegal drugs or weapons\*.
- f. Being out of bunks between "lights out" and "rise and shine," except to use the restrooms or to visit the infirmary with your counselor\*.

\*Violation of this rule will result in an immediate dismissal from camp upon the first offense.

## VI. Dress Code

- a. Underwear and midriffs should be fully covered.
- b. When your hands are by your side, **shorts and skirts should extend to at least the end of your thumb.**
- c. Piercings may be in your ears only.
- d. Footwear should be worn at all times (closed toed).
- e. No spaghetti straps.
- f. No visible tattoos.
- g. Natural hair colors

Repeated violations of the rules in "Behavior and Dress Code" may also result in dismissal from camp.
